- Jubilee Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds and Font
- Jubilee CS® Wood Mounted “Celebration Patchwork” Stamp
- Jubilee “Partay” Art Nouveau Stamp
- Jubilee “Celebrate” Greeting Stamp

Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of many finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

Remove the die cuts from the Grey 12x12 Sheet and nest the components. Trim the sheet of Dark Pink Cutaparts according to the cutting guidelines.

If you do not have an item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use items that you have in your stash.



Set A: 3-1/2x5" Dark Pink Cards with 3-1/4x4-3/4" Light Pink Panels

Card #1



- Dark Pink Card with Light Pink Panel
- Nested Grey Die Cuts: "Celebrate"
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Organza and Satin Ribbon

1. Stamp the UM image onto the Light Pink panel with Fuchsia ink. (Stamp the image on copy paper first to remove some of the ink before stamping on the panel.)
2. Staple a double layer of ribbon to each end of the nested die cuts. Layer the die cut onto the panel with foam adhesive and attach the panel to the card.

Card #2



- Dark Pink Card with Light Pink Panel
- Nested Grey Die Cuts: "Celebrate Yesterday..."

1. Staple the nested die cut together at the top. Attach to the top of the Light Pink panel and tear away the bottom edge of the panel.
2. Layer the panel onto the card. Apply glitter glue around the perimeter of the star and set aside to dry.

Card #3



- Dark Pink Card with Light Pink Panel
- Wood Mounted "Celebration Patchwork" Stamp
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- White Photo Mounting Corners

1. Ink the four quadrants of the WM stamp with Leaf, Sapphire, Amethyst and Fuchsia ink. Stamp onto the center of the Light Pink panel.
2. Stamp the UM image at the bottom of the panel, and attach to the card with white photo mounting corners.

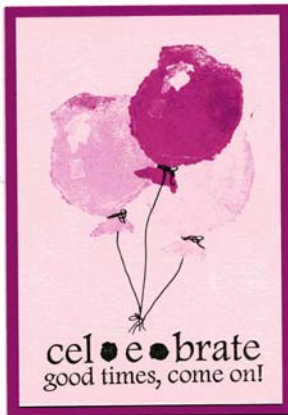


Card #4



- Dark Pink Card with Light Pink Panel
 - Nesting Grey Die Cuts: Birthday Gift
 - Organza Ribbon
1. Staple the nested die cut together and attach to the upper center of the Light Pink panel with foam adhesive.
 2. Tie ribbon onto the bottom portion of the panel, round corners and attach to the card.

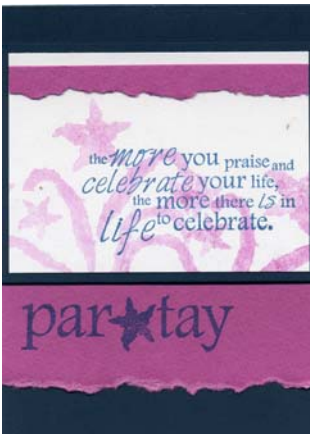
Card #5



- Dark Pink Card with Light Pink Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - "Celebrate" Greeting Stamp
1. Stamp the UM balloon image three times without re-inking onto the Light Pink panel. Draw a tie and string onto each balloon with a black pen.
 2. Stamp the WM greeting onto the bottom of the panel with Onyx ink; attach the panel to the card.

Set B: 4x5.5" Midnight Z-Fold Cards with 3x4" Dark Pink and 2-3/4x3-3/4" Grey Panels

Card #1



- Midnight Card with Dark Pink and Grey Panels
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - "Partay" Art Nouveau Stamp
1. Stamp the UM starburst onto the Grey panel with Fuchsia ink. (Stamp first onto copy paper to lighten the ink.) Stamp the UM quote onto the panel with Sapphire ink.
 2. Tear a small amount of paper from the short edge of the Dark Pink panel. Attach the torn strip to the top edge of the Grey panel and trim length to fit.
 3. Attach the Dark Pink panel to the inside of the Z-fold card so that the torn edge of the panel is revealed, as shown. Stamp "Partay" onto the bottom of the panel with Sapphire ink.



Card #2



- Midnight Card with Dark Pink and Grey Panels
 - Nested Grey Die Cuts: Cupcake
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Satin Ribbon
1. Layer the nested die cuts at the top of the Grey panel; stamp "Celebrate" onto the bottom of the panel with Sapphire ink. Attach to the front fold of the card.
 2. Staple three satin ribbons to the right edge of the Dark Pink panel and attach to the inside of the card.

Card #3



- Midnight Card with Dark Pink and Grey Panels
 - Dark Pink Cutapart
 - Grey Nested Die Cuts: "Let's get this party started!"
 - White String
1. Tear the framed balloon from the Dark Pink Cutapart sheet. Poke holes on each side of the balloon base, thread with white string, and tie a bow with a long tail. Attach to the upper left corner of the front card panel.
 2. Staple the Grey nested die cuts together and attach to the front card panel.
 3. Tear the right edge of the Grey panel; nest onto the Dark Pink panel and attach to the inside of the card.

Card #4



- Midnight Card with Dark Pink and Grey Panels
 - Dark Pink Cutapart: "Too much of a good thing..."
 - Organza Ribbon
1. Staple ribbon onto the upper left corner of the Dark Pink cutapart. Attach at an angle onto the Grey panel with foam adhesive. Layer the panel onto the front of the card.
 2. Attach the Dark Pink panel to the inside of the card, revealing the edge around the Grey panel, as shown.



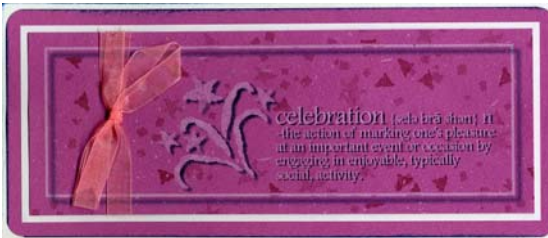
Card #5



- Midnight Card with Dark Pink and Grey Panels
 - “Partay” Art Nouveau Stamp
 - Satin Ribbon
1. Stamp “Partay” onto the Grey panel several times without re-inking. Attach a small satin bow onto the lower right corner of the panel.
 2. Attach the Grey panel to the front of the card, and align the Dark Pink panel on the inside of the card.

Set C: 4x9-1/4” Grey Cards with 3-3/4x9 Dark Pink and 3-1/4x8-1/2” Translucent Panels

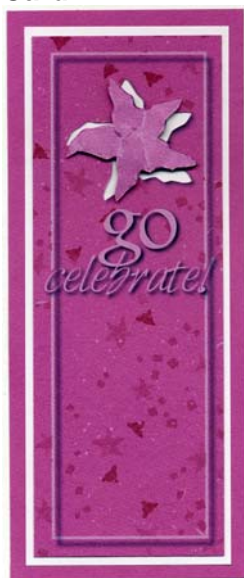
Card #1



- Grey Card with Dark Pink and Translucent Panels
- Dark Pink Cutapart: “Celebration”
- Organza Ribbon

1. Tie ribbon around the left edge of the cutapart. Layer onto the Translucent and Dark Pink panels.
2. Round the corners of the Dark Pink panel and attach to the Grey card.

Card #2



- Grey Card with Dark Pink and Translucent Panels
 - Dark Pink Cutapart: “Go Celebrate”
1. Carefully remove the star from the Dark Pink cutapart with a craft knife and cutting mat.
 2. Attach the cutapart to the Translucent and Dark Pink panels, and layer onto the Grey card.
 3. Add the star to the card with foam adhesive, as shown.



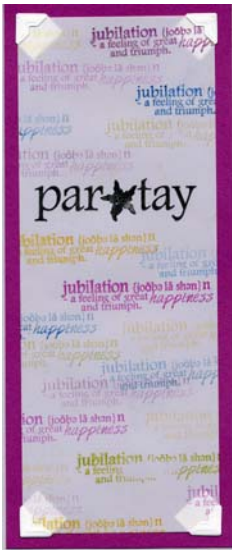
Card #3



- Grey Card with Dark Pink and Translucent Panels
- (2) Pink Jewel Brads
- Grey Nested Die Cuts: "Young Once"

1. Slide the Translucent panel through the slots in the Grey nested die cuts. Layer onto the Dark Pink panel.
2. Attach the jewel brads, as shown, and layer the panels onto the card.

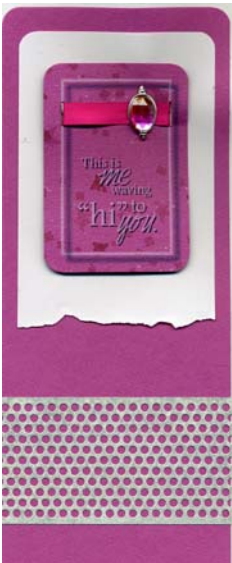
Card #4



- Grey Card with Dark Pink and Translucent Panels
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- "Partay" Art Nouveau Stamp

1. Stamp "Partay" into the upper center of the Translucent panel.
2. Cover the remaining portion of the panel with the UM image and assorted ink colors; attach to the Dark Pink panel with photo mounting corners. Layer the panels onto the Grey card.

Card #5



- Grey Card with Dark Pink and Translucent Panels
- Dark Pink Cutapart: "Waving Hi"
- Silver Dotty Mesh
- Satin Ribbon
- Pink Jewel Brad

1. Using a craft knife, make a narrow slit in the upper left and right edges of the Dark Pink Cutapart. Thread the ribbon through the slits, and secure with a pink jewel brad.
2. Round the corners of the Cutapart and layer onto the upper half of the Translucent panel with foam adhesive. Round the top two corners of the Translucent panel, tear the bottom edge, and layer onto the Dark Pink panel.
3. Add a strip of Dotty Mesh to the bottom of the panel and attach to the Grey card.
