Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of many finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

If you do not have an item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use items that you have in your stash.

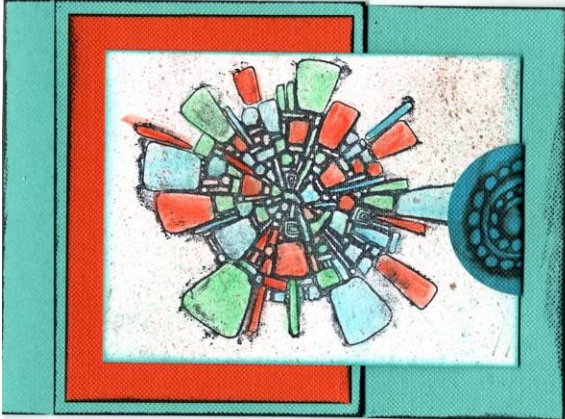


Preparation: Remove the components from each sheet of Sky Blue die cuts. Match up the coordinating pairs back to back, and glue them together with a thin coat of CS® Bookbinding Glue. Fold along score lines with a bone folder to create the interactive elements.

Set A: 4x5-1/2 Sea Green “Z-fold” Cards with White and Paprika Panels

For best results, fold the cards so that the textured side faces up on the inside of the card as well as the narrow panel on the outside front.

Card #1



- Sea Green Card with Paprika and White Panels
 - WM Sunburst Stamp
 - Sky Blue Die Cut: Circular Image
 - Watercolor Pencils
 - Waterbrush
1. Stamp the WM sunburst image with black ink onto the White panel. Color with pencil colors and blend with the waterbrush. Splatter the panel with additional watercolors.
 2. Attach the Paprika panel to the front portion of the “Z-fold” card, and center the White panel horizontally.
 3. Fold the Sky Blue die cut in half and attach to the right edge of the White panel.

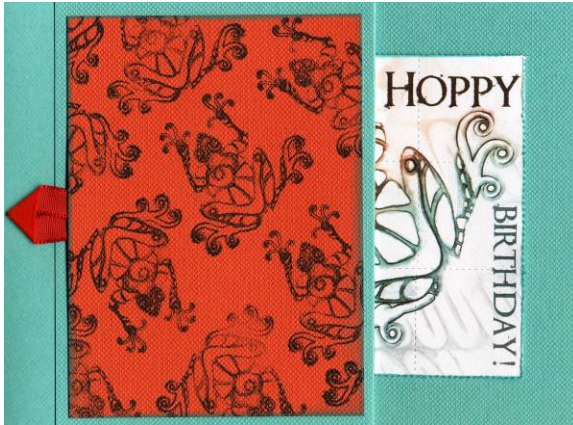
Card #2



- Sea Green Card with Paprika and White Panels
 - Sky Blue Die Cut: “Happy Anniversary”
 - Black Brad
 - White Perforated Squares: “Congratulations” Strip
1. Attach the Sky Blue die cut onto the White panel, as shown. Set a black brad into the hole on the right edge of the die cut.
 2. Place the strip of perforated squares into the inside of the card, centered, so that the colorful edge of the strips peeks beyond the edge of the panel.

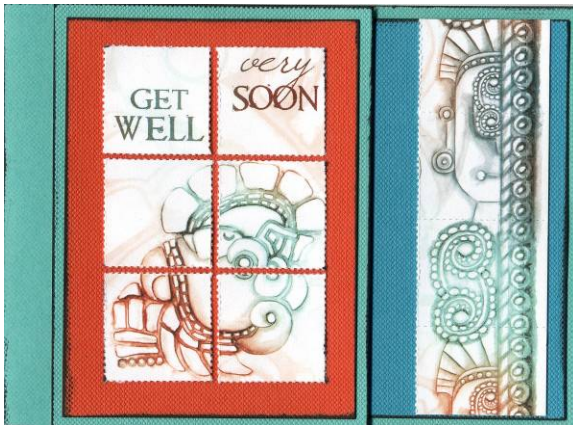


Card #3



- Sea Green Card with Paprika Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Black Ink
 - White Perforated Squares: "Hoppy Birthday"
 - Paprika Satin Ribbon
1. Stamp the Paprika panel with the UM frog image and black ink. Make a loop with the satin ribbon and attach to the left edge of the panel before layering onto the card.
 2. Attach the entire 9-square "Hoppy Birthday" image to the inside of the card.

Card #4



- Sea Green Card with Paprika Panel
 - Sky Blue Panel (From Set C)
 - White Perforated Squares: "Get Well Very Soon" and Decorative Border
1. Tear apart and piece together the six perforated squares onto the Paprika panel and attach to the front of the card.
 2. Trim the Sky Blue panel horizontally at 5.25". Attach to the inside of the card. Attach the White perforated square strip to the right edge of the inner panel, trimming to fit.

Card #5

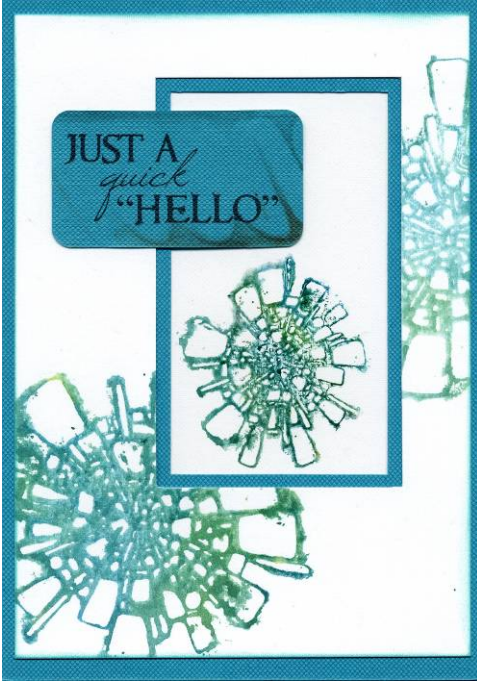


- Sea Green Card with Paprika and White Panels
 - Remaining Sky Blue Panel (From Set A, Card #4)
 - Teal Organza Ribbon
 - White Perforated Squares: "I'm Sorry"
1. Place the Sky Blue panel horizontally onto the card front, as shown.
 2. Tie a small bow with the organza ribbon and attach to the upper left corner of the nested panels. Layer the message to the lower right corner of the panel.



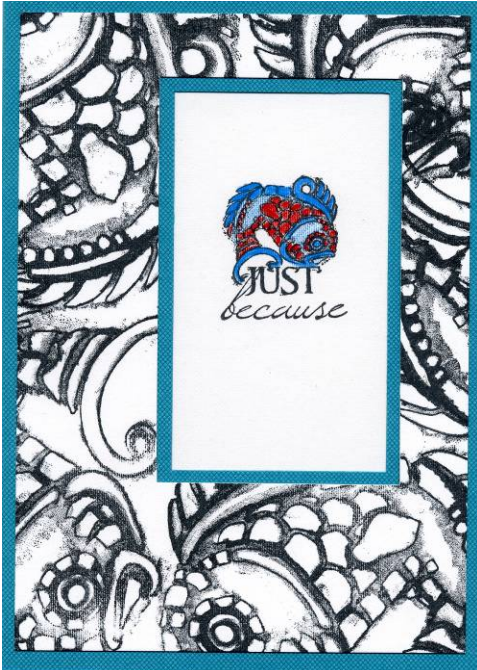
Set B: 4-1/4 x 6-1/4 Sky Blue Die Cut Cards with White Die Cut Outer Panels and White Inner Panels

Card #1



- Sky Blue Card with White Panels
 - Sky Blue Die Cut: "Just a Quick Hello"
 - WM Sunburst Stamp
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Watercolor Crayons and Water Spray Bottle
1. Temporarily place the White panel inside the card and lightly mark the location of the window on the panel. Remove the panel.
 2. Lightly mist the WM sunburst stamp with water, color with watercolor crayons, and stamp onto the White die cut panel. Spray without coloring, and stamp again.
 3. Mist the UM sunburst stamp with water, color with crayons, and stamp within the lower portion of the marked window area on the White panel.
 4. Attach the Sky Blue die cut to the White panel so that it enters the die cut area.

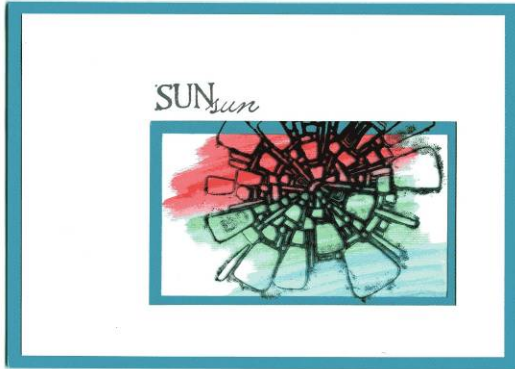
Card #2



- Sky Blue Card with White Panels
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Black Ink
 - WM "Just Because" Stamp
 - Colored Pencils
1. Stamp the White die cut panel with the large UM fish image and black ink until the entire panel is patterned.
 2. Place the White panel inside the card and stamp the WM image into the center of the window with black ink. Color the image with colored pencils.



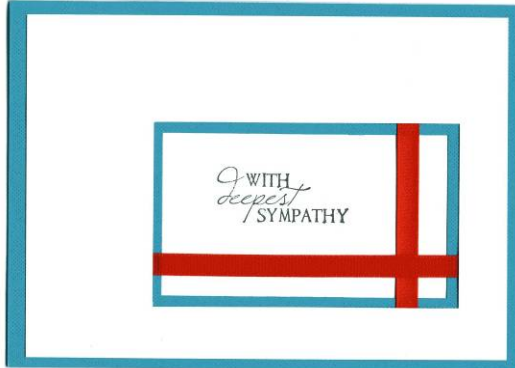
Card #3



- Sky Blue Card with White Panels
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- WM Sunburst Stamp
- Watercolor Pencils or Crayons
- Waterbrush
- Transparency Film
- Black Solvent Ink

1. Stamp the WM image onto a piece of transparency film with black solvent ink. Trim slightly larger than the die cut window. Attach to the underside of the White die cut panel, and layer the panel onto the card.
2. Stamp the UM “sun” onto the White die cut panel.
3. Add several scribbles of color to the inside White panel with a crayon or pencil and blend with a waterbrush.

Card #4



- Sky Blue Card with White Panels
- WM “With Deepest Sympathy” Stamp
- Black Ink
- Paprika Satin Ribbon

1. Tape the ribbon to the back of the White die cut panel, as shown; layer onto the card.
2. Attach the White panel to the inside of the card and stamp the WM image into the die cut opening with black ink. (Love the simplicity and beauty!)

Card #5



- Sky Blue Card with White Panels
- Teal Organza Ribbon
- White Perforated Squares: “Happy Anniversary”

1. Place the greeting within the lower portion of the die cut window, and attach a bow of organza just above it for a simple, sweet card.



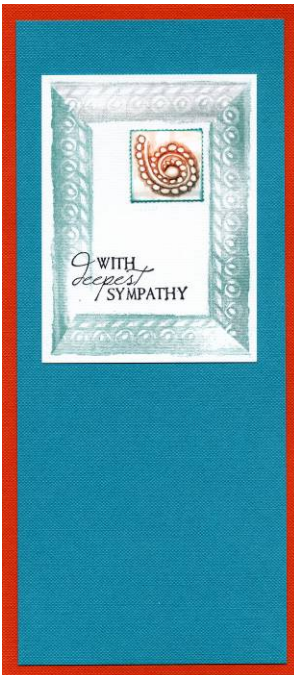
Set C: 4-1/4 x 9-1/2 Paprika Cards with Sky Blue Panels

Card #1



- Paprika Card with Sky Blue Panel
 - White Perforated Squares: "Fish" and "Wish You Were Here"
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Black Ink
 - Paprika Satin Ribbon
 - Paper Distressing Tool
1. Stamp the entire Sky Blue panel with the large UM fish image and black ink. Wrap a length of satin ribbon around the bottom of the panel and tie a short ribbon around it to "fake" a bow.
 2. Layer the "Wish You Were Here" image beneath the ribbon. Tear out the large White perforated fish image, distress the edges, and reassemble onto the top portion of the card. (Distressing the edges takes quite a bit of time, so skip this step if you're in a hurry.)

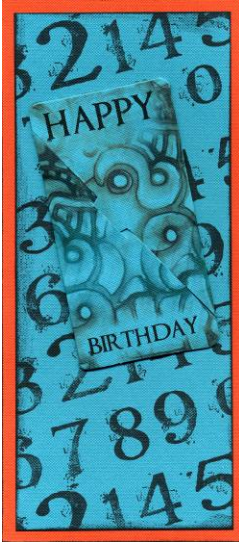
Card #2



- Paprika Card with Sky Blue Panel
 - White Panel (From Set A)
 - WM "With Deepest Sympathy" Stamp
 - White Perforated Squares: Circular Image
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Turquoise Gem Ink
1. Place a mask at a 45 degree angle on the two bottom corners of the White panel. Stamp the UM border image with Turquoise Gem ink. Remove the masks, and place on the next pair of corners, and stamp the border image again. Repeat for the remaining sides to create a frame.
 2. Stamp the WM image into the lower left corner and place the White Perforated Square in the upper right corner of the panel.



Card #3



- Paprika Card with Sky Blue Panel
- Sky Blue Die Cut: "Happy Birthday"
- UM Font
- Black Ink

1. Stamp the numbers from the UM Font in repeated rows at an angle onto the Sky Blue Panel.
2. Layer the interactive die cut onto the front of the panel.

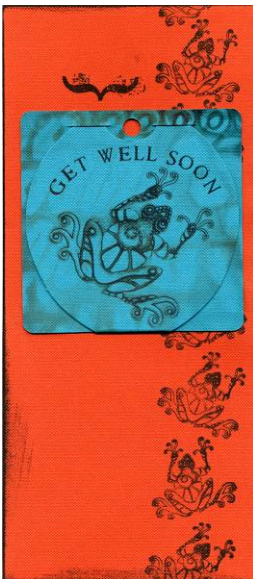
Card #4



- Paprika Card with Sky Blue Panel
- White Perforated Squares: Art Strip
- Sky Blue Die Cut: "With Deepest Sympathy"
- Paprika Satin Ribbon

1. Separate the long narrow strip of White Perforated Squares and split between the top and bottom half of the Sky Blue panel. Position the Sky Blue die cut to hide the gap in the strip.
2. Attach a length of ribbon to the hole in the die cut.

Card #5



- Paprika Card
- Sky Blue Die Cut: "Get Well Soon"
- UM Font
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Black Ink

1. Stamp the UM frog image along the right edge of the card with black ink. Attach the die cut to the card and stamp the UM "bracket" image above the die cut.
