Materials:

- *Just Dandy* Greetings to Go
- *Just Dandy* Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds and FontArt
- *Just Dandy* Club Scrap® Unmounted Stamps
- *Just Dandy* Stencil
- *Just Dandy* Metal “Friends” Word Tile (CS® Goodie)
- *Just Dandy* Golden and Copper Text Weight Paper

Tools and Supplies:

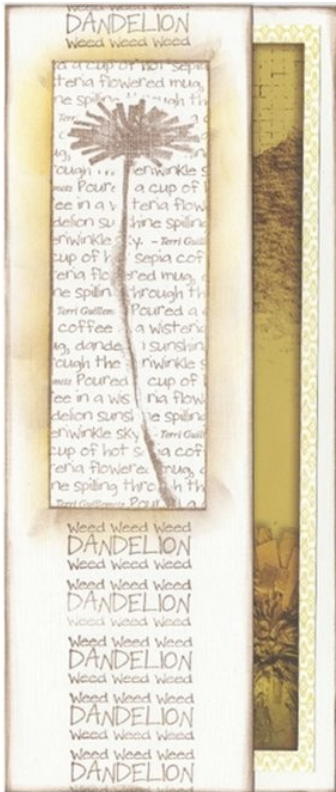
- 12” Paper Trimmer
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Tape
- Foam Adhesive
- Crop-A-Dile
- Paper Piercing Tool and Cork Board
- CS® Earth, Leaf and Topaz Inks
- CS® Ink Applicator
- CS® Grid Ruler
- Craft Knife and Cutting Mat
- Scrap Paper for Masking
- Ivory Waxed Linen Thread
- Bookbinding Needle
- Jute Fiber
- 1/4” Hole Punch
- 1” Circle Punch
- Black Fine Tip Pen
- CS® Bookbinding Glue
- (2) [Brown Buttons](#) (03/10 Sonoma Goodie)

Notes: Trim the White and Golden Cutaparts according to the artwork.

If you do not have an item required to complete a card, simply omit the step or substitute the item.

Set A: 3 7/8 x 9 1/8" White Cards with 2 3/8 x 6 3/4" Green Pattern Panels

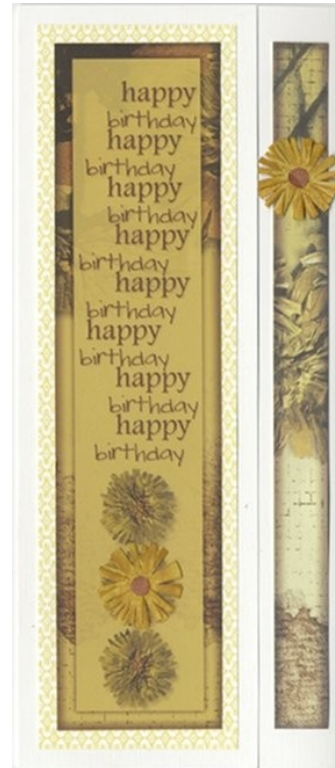

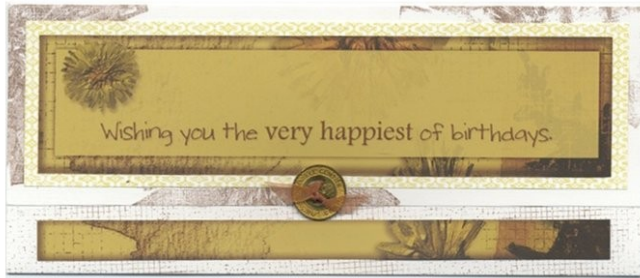
- White Card with Green Pattern Panel
 - Golden Cutapart: Narrow Strip
 - UM FontArt and Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM FontArt image onto the upper half of the wide card panel with Earth ink. Mask the image with scrap paper and sponge ink to create a glow. Stamp the UM B&B image above and below the focal image with Earth ink.
 2. Attach the Green Pattern panel to the short flap of the card, being careful with adhesive placement. Adhere the Golden strip to the panel.

- White Card with Green Pattern Panel
 - Ivory Cutaparts: "Simply the Best" and Narrow Strip
 - White Fiber
1. Nest the Ivory cutout onto the Green Pattern panel. Wrap with white fiber and secure ends on the back with tape. Attach to the wide flap of the card. Layer the remaining Ivory strip to the narrow card flap.

- White Card with Green Pattern Panel
 - Golden Cutapart: "Happy Birthday"
 - Ivory Cutapart: Narrow Strip
 - Golden and Copper Text
1. Nest the Golden cutapart onto the Green Pattern panel and attach to the wide flap of the card. Layer the Ivory strip onto the narrow flap.
 2. Follow the steps in the *Scrap Rap* to create two handmade dandelions with the Golden and Copper Text papers, the 1" circle punch, 1/4" punch, and Topaz ink. Adhere the flowers onto the card, as shown.



Card #4



- White Card with Green Pattern Panel
- Golden Cutaparts: "Happiest of Birthdays" and Narrow Strip
- CS® UM Stamps
- Rust Organza Fiber
- Metal Coin

1. Stamp the White card with the dandelion and screen images from the CS UM stamps using Earth ink.
2. Nest the Golden cutpart onto the Green Pattern panel and layer onto the wide flap of the card. Center the Golden strip onto the narrow flap of the card.
3. Thread ribbon through the metal coin and adhere to the center edge of the wide card flap.

Card #5



- White Card with Green Pattern Panel
 - Ivory Cutpart: "Happy Anniversary"
 - CS® UM Stamps
1. Stamp the UM images onto the White card with Topaz and Earth inks.
 2. Nest the Ivory cutpart onto the Green Pattern panel and attach to the wide flap of the card.

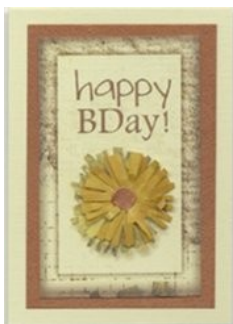
Set B: 2 3/8 x 3 3/8" Ivory Cards with 2x3" Copper Panels

Card #1



- Ivory Card with Copper Panel
 - Ivory Cutpart: "You Are a Treasure"
 - Jute Fiber
1. Using a Crop-A-Dile, punch six 1/8" holes into the Copper panel and Ivory cutpart, as shown.
 2. Tie jute fiber onto the six holes in the cutpart and attach to the Copper panel with foam adhesive. Layer the panel onto the card.

Card #2



- Ivory Card with Copper Panel
 - Golden and Copper Text Weight Papers
1. Following the technique featured in July's *Scrap Rap*, create a dandelion with the Golden and Copper papers.
 2. Attach the handmade dandelion to the pre-printed dandelion on the cutpart and adhere the cutpart onto the panel. Layer the panel onto the card.

Card #3



- Ivory Card with Copper Panel
 - Golden and Copper Text Weight Papers
 - Ivory Cutapart: "Weed, Weed, Weed. . ."
 - Rust Organza Ribbon
1. Tie a bow with organza ribbon and attach to the upper left corner of the cutapart. Layer onto the Copper panel and adhere to the card.

Card #4



- Ivory Card with Copper Panel
 - Ivory Cutapart: "Hi!"
 - (2) Brown Buttons
 - Ivory Waxed Linen Thread
1. Thread waxed linen through the brown buttons, tie in a knot, and attach to the pre-printed dandelions on the cutapart.
 2. Adhere the cutapart to the panel and the panel to the card.

Card #5



- Ivory Card with Copper Panel
 - Ivory Cutapart: Dandelion with Text
 - Rust Organza Ribbon
1. Using a ruler, cutting mat and craft knife, cut the frame from the Ivory cutapart. Trim the border from the edge of the inner image.
 2. Tie two ribbons around the upper right edge of the frame and attach to the Copper panel. Layer the inner image to the panel with foam adhesive and adhere the panel to the card.

Set C: 4 3/4 x 3 1/2" Green Pattern Cards with 3 1/2 x 3" Golden Panels

Card #1



- Green Pattern Card with Golden Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM quote onto the Golden panel with Earth ink. Stamp the UM dandelion stem with Earth ink and the flower bud with Topaz ink. Stamp twice onto the Golden panel, and adhere the panel to the card.

Card #2



- Green Pattern Card with Golden Panel
 - Ivory Cutapart: "With Deepest Sympathy"
 - Waxed Linen Thread
1. Nest the Ivory cutapart onto the Golden panel.
 2. Using a paper piercing tool, ruler and cork board, pierce a row of holes every half inch into the upper edge of the Ivory cutapart, just inside the frame.
 3. Whip stitch around the top edge of the cutapart with waxed linen thread. Nest the stitched panel onto the card.

Card #3



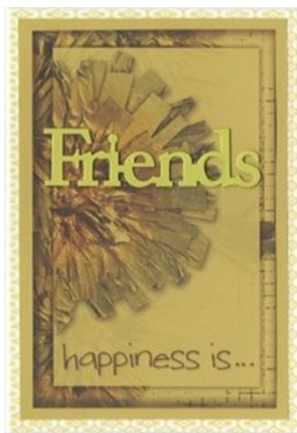
- Green Pattern Card with Golden Panel
 - Ivory Cutapart: "May the Sun Shine. . ."
 - Metal Coin
 - Rust Organza Ribbon
1. Nest the cutapart and panel onto the card.
 2. Thread ribbon through the coin and attach to the lower left corner of the cutapart.

Card #4



- Green Pattern Card with Golden Panel
 - Stencil
 - CS® Unmounted Stamps
1. Stencil the dandelion bud onto the Golden panel with Topaz and Leaf inks.
 2. Stamp the UM text onto the right edge of the panel with Earth ink. Stamp "Life is Dandy" onto the lower center of the panel with Earth ink.
 3. Using a ruler and black pen, draw a double-line frame around the perimeter of the panel. Attach the panel to the card.

Card #5



- Green Pattern Card with Golden Panel
 - Golden Cutapart: "Happiness is. . ."
 - Metal "Friends" Word Tile
1. Gently dab CS® Bookbinding Glue onto the back of the metal word tile and place onto the Golden cutapart. Apply gentle pressure and allow the glue to set. (Bookbinding Glue works great for adhering metal embellishments to almost any surface!) Adhere the panel to the card.
