- 3x13" CS® Grid Ruler
- Adhesive
- Stylus Tool
- Embossing Powder
- Heat Tool
- Wine Ink
- CS® Onyx Ink

Fraction to Decimal Conversions

$1/8" = .125"$ $1/2" = .5"$ $7/8" = .875"$

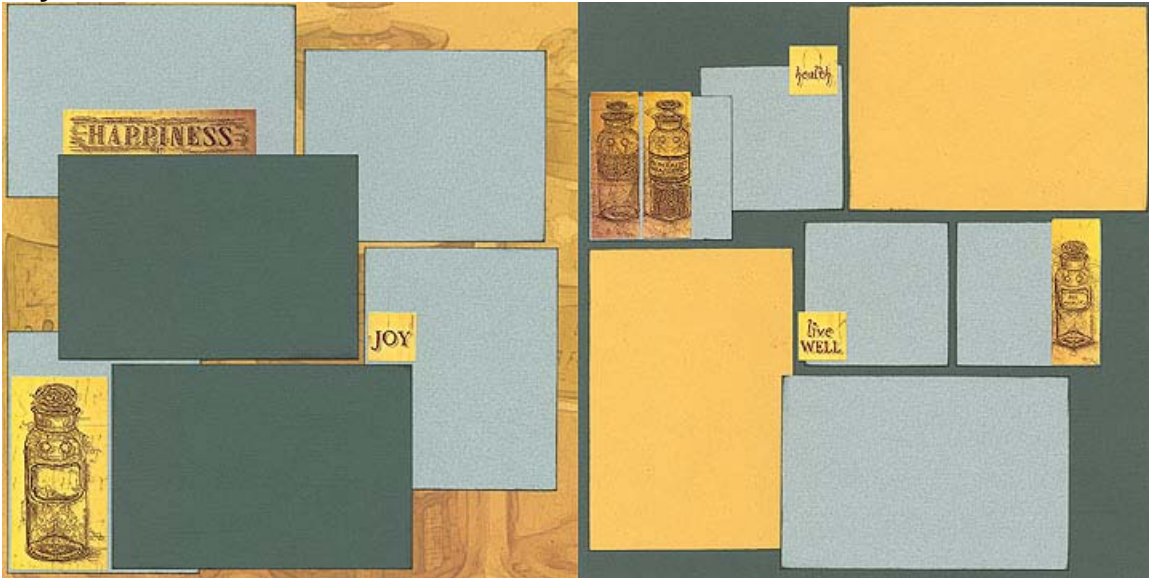
$1/4" = .25"$ $5/8" = .625"$

$3/8" = .375"$ $3/4" = .75"$



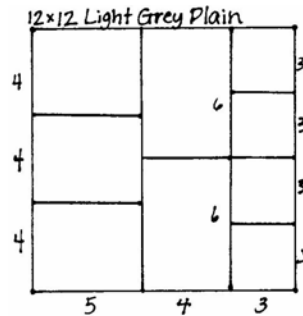
The edges of many pages, photo mattes, and other elements have been edged with black ink; however, instructions to do so are not included below.

Layout #1 and #2

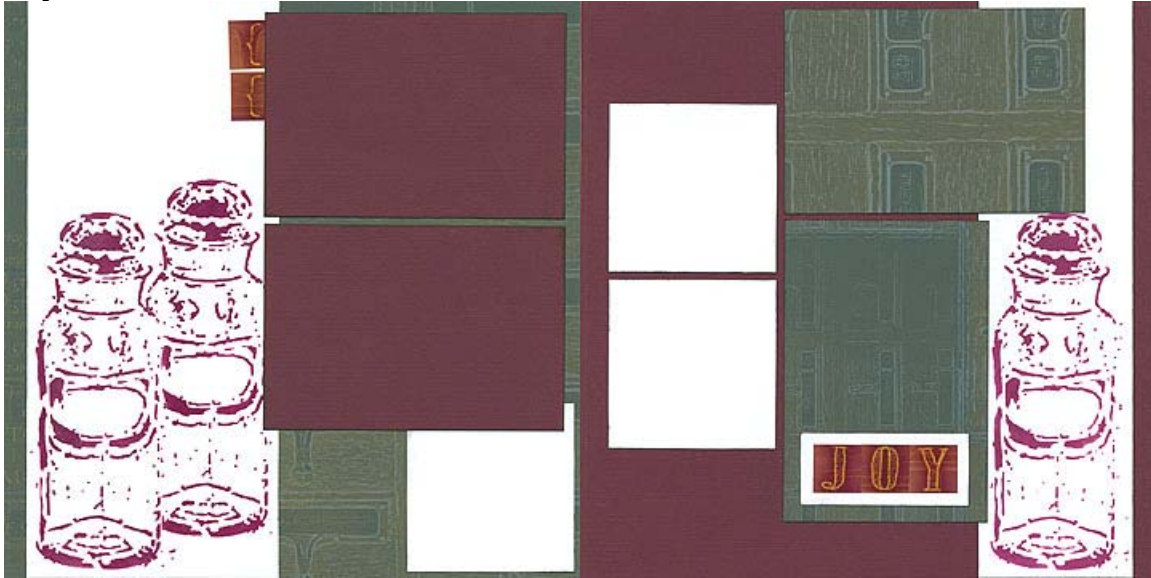


- 12x12 Gold Print
- 12x12 Dark Grey Plain
- 12x12 Light Grey Plain
- (2) 4.25x6.25 Dark Grey Plain Photo Mattes
- (2) 4.25x6.25 Gold Plain Photo Mattes
- Stickers

1. Trim the 12x12 Light Grey Plain at 9 and 5". Cut the 5x12 horizontally at 8 and 4". Trim the 4x12 horizontally at 6". Cut the 3x12 horizontally at 9, 6, and 3".

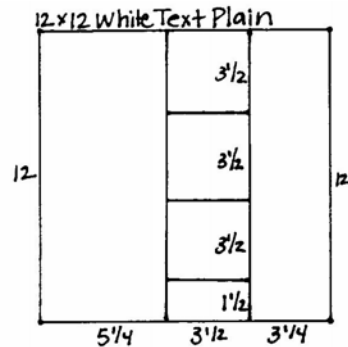


Layout #3 and #4



- 12x12 Dark Grey Print
- 12x12 Wine Plain
- 12x12 White Text Plain
- (2) 4.25x6.25 Dark Grey Print Photo Mattes
- (2) 4.25x6.25 Wine Plain Photo Mattes
- Stickers
- Wine Ink
- Stencil

1. Trim the 12x12 White Text Plain at 8.75 and 5.25".
Cut the 3.5x12 horizontally at 10.5, 7, and 3.5".

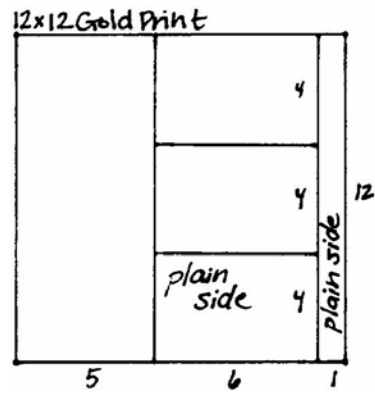


Layout #5 and #6

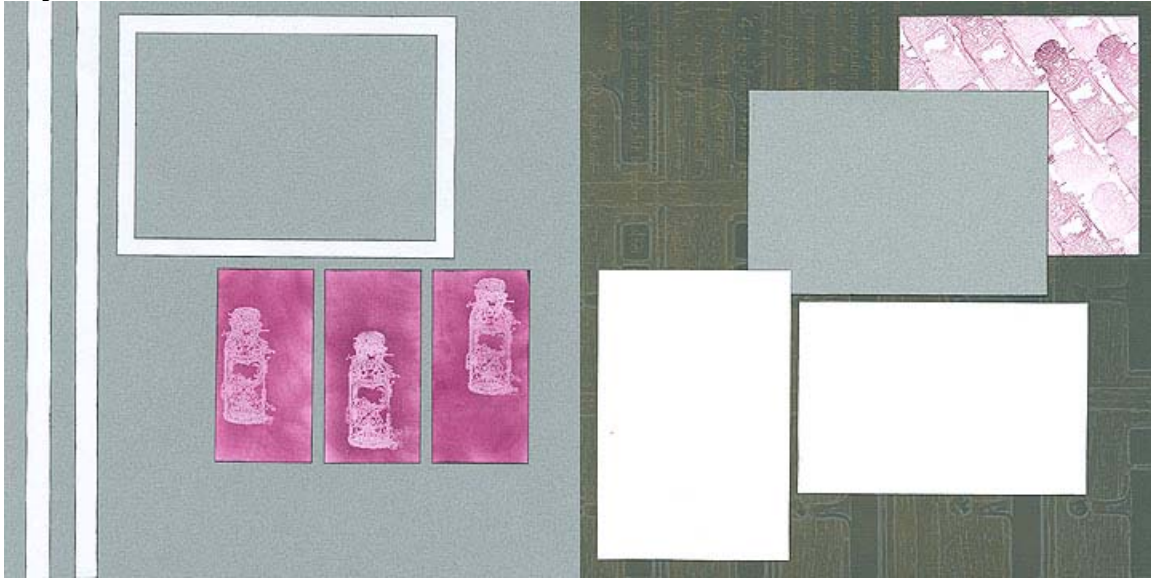


- 12x12 Wine Plain
- 12x12 Dark Grey Plain
- 12x12 Gold Print
- (2) 4.25x6.25 White Text Plain Photo Mattes
- Stickers

1. Trim the 12x12 Gold Print at 11 and 5". Cut the 6x12 horizontally at 8 and 4".



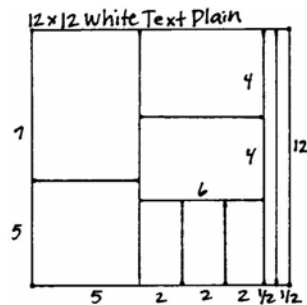
Layout #7 and #8



- 12x12 Dark Grey Print
- 12x12 Light Grey Plain
- 12x12 White Text Plain
- (2) 4.25x6.25 Light Grey Plain Photo Mattes

- Wood Mounted Stamp
- Embossing Ink Pad
- Embossing Powder
- Wine Ink

1. Trim the 12x12 White Text Plain at 11.5, 11, and 5". Cut the 5x12 horizontally at 7". Trim the 6x12 horizontally at 8 and 4". Cut one 4x6 horizontally at 4 and 2".



2. Stamp the bottle image with embossing ink onto each 2x4" rectangle; sprinkle powder over the stamped image, shake off excess, and use heat tool to melt powder. Cover image and surrounding area with wine ink. Remove ink from embossed area with paper towel to reveal stamped image.
