Materials:

- *Comfort Zone* CS® JR Kit

Tools and Supplies:

- 12" Paper Trimmer
- Adhesive
- 3x13" CS® Grid Ruler
- CS® India Black, Earth and Rust Ink
- CS® Ink Applicator
- Craft Knife and Cutting Mat

Measurement Conversions:

.25 = $\frac{1}{4}$ "

.5 = $\frac{1}{2}$ "

.75 = $\frac{3}{4}$ "

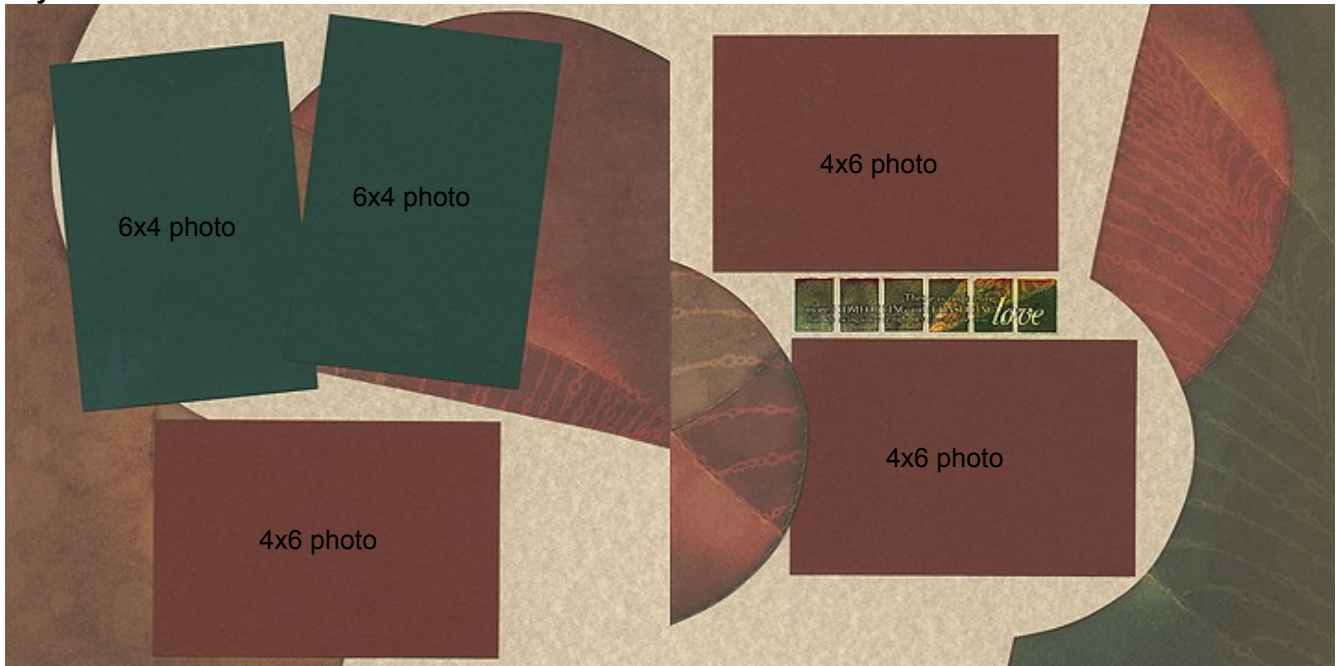
LB = Left Base Paper

RB = Right Base Paper

Note: If you do not have the items needed to complete the layouts as shown, simply omit or substitute with an alternate item from your stash.



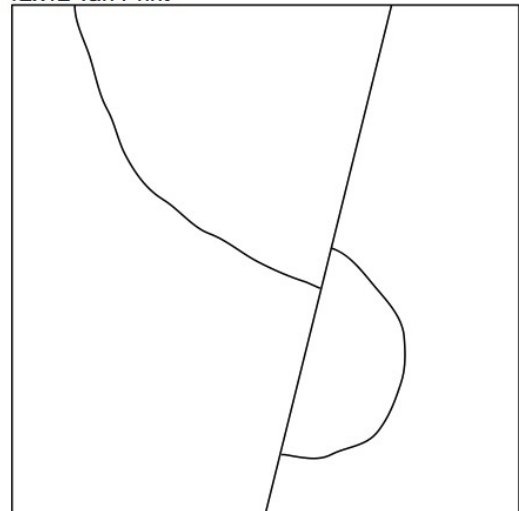
Layout 1 & 2



- (2) 12x12 Parchment Plains (LB & RB)
- 12x12 Tan Print
- (2) 4.25x6.25 Green Photo Mattes
- (3) 4.25x6.25 Rust Photo Mattes
- JR Stickers

1. Cut the 12x12 Tan Print with a craft knife, using the pre-printed art as your guiding guide. Make the first diagonal straight line cut with a ruler. Free-hand cut the remaining curved lines.

Layout 5 & 6



- (2) 12x12 Tan Plains (LB & RB)
- 12x12 Pumpkin Print
- (3) 4.25x6.25 Pumpkin Photo Mattes
- (2) 1.5x1.5 Tan Prints (From 3&4)
- Stencil
- JR Stickers
- (6) Flower Embellishments

1. Trim the 12x12 Pumpkin Print at 10.5, 8.75 and 5". Cut the 5x12 horizontally at 9.5 and 7". Trim each 2.5x5 horizontally at 2.5". Cut the 3.75x12 horizontally at 8.5 and 5".

Layout 7 & 8



- (2) 12x12 Green Plains (LB & RB)
- 12x12 Pumpkin Print
- (2) 3.5x3.75 Pumpkin Prints (From 5&6)
- 4x5.5 Tan Print (From 3&4)
- (2) 4.25x6.25 Parchment Photo Mattes
- JR Stickers
- JR Unmounted Stamps

1. Use a craft knife to freehand cut along the pre-printed curved lines, as shown in the diagram. Trim the remaining portion vertically at 5.75". Cut the 5.75x12 horizontally at 8 and 4".
2. Stamp the UM leaf image several times onto the plain side of the 4x5.5" Tan Print with India Black. Color the leaves with your desired art medium, and trim with craft knife. Shape and arrange onto a handmade paper "stem." View this [technique video](#) for tips.
