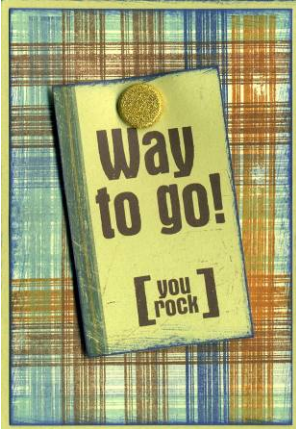
Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making crease, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of most finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with black or brown ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

If you do not have the item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use the items that you have in your stash.



Set A: 3-3/8 x 4-7/8 Dark Celery Cards with Light Celery Panels

Card #1



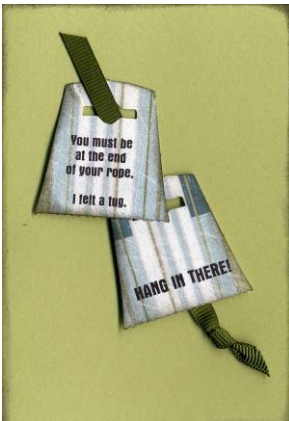
- Dark Celery Card with Light Celery Panel
 - Dark Celery CutApart: "Way to Go!"
 - Round Sparkle Brad
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Assorted Ink Colors
 - Foam Tape
1. Create a unique plaid background with the striped stamp from the UM Borders & Backgrounds. Stamp the panel several times vertically and horizontally until you're pleased with the color and pattern.
 2. Secure a brad at the top of the CutApart, and layer onto the panel with foam tape to add dimension.

Card #2



- Dark Celery Card with Light Celery Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds and Font
 - Stone Die Cut Tag: "Be Well..."
 - Organza Ribbon
 - CS® "Moss" and "Earth" Ink
1. Stamp the Light Celery panel with the unique UM background image and Moss ink.
 2. Stamp "HI" onto the tag with the UM font and Earth ink.

Card #3



- Dark Celery Card
 - Stone Die Cut Tags: "You Might Be..." and "Hang in There!"
 - Green Grosgrain Ribbon
 - Foam Tape
1. Trim a length of ribbon, tie a knot at the end, and thread through the die cut tags. Secure the ribbon at back and attach to the card with foam tape.

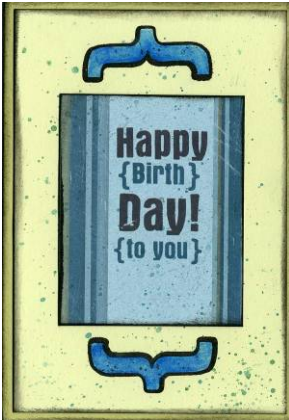


Card #4



- Dark Celery Card with Light Celery Panel
 - Dark Celery CutApart: "Hi!"
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds and Font
 - Green Grosgrain Ribbon
 - Assorted Ink Colors
1. Stamp the background with the wide strip image from the UM Borders & Backgrounds and assorted ink colors. Stamp three or four times in each color, choosing a light, medium and dark shade.

Card #5



- Dark Celery Card with Light Celery Panel
 - Robin's Egg CutApart: "Happy Birthday to You"
 - UM Font
 - Blue Watercolor Pencil and Waterbrush
 - Black Ink
1. Stamp the UM bracket image above and below the CutApart. Blend blue watercolor onto the stamped image. Splatter additional blue watercolor onto the finished card.

Set B: 5-1/4 x 5-1/4 Brown Cards with Robin's Egg Panels

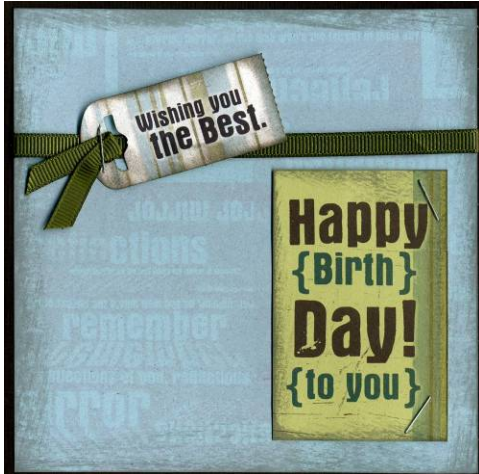
Card #1



- Brown Card with Robin's Egg Panel
 - UM Font
 - Watercolor Pencils and Waterbrush
 - CS® "Earth" Ink
1. Stamp the word "Congrats" at an angle onto the panel with the UM font and Earth ink.
 2. Fill in the letters with brown, soft green and blue watercolor pencils. Blend the color with the waterbrush.
 3. Splatter the panel with additional watercolor. Draw a line around the perimeter of the panel with a watercolor pencil; blend with the waterbrush.



Card #2



- Brown Card with Robin's Egg Panel
 - WM Word Collage Stamp
 - Stone Die Cut Tag: "Wishing You the Best"
 - Dark Celery CutApart: "Happy Birthday to You"
 - Light Blue or Watermark Ink
 - Green Grosgrain Ribbon
1. Stamp the panel repeatedly with the WM Word Collage with tone on tone or watermark ink to create the background.
 2. Wrap one length of ribbon around the entire panel. Staple a short length of ribbon to the die cut and layer the die cut right over the ribbon.

Card #3



- Brown Card with Robin's Egg Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Dark Celery CutAparts: "Wishing You the Best" and "Happy Anniversary"
 - CS® "Earth" Ink
1. Stamp the UM arrow image full strength onto the panel with Earth ink. Stamp again without re-inking, being sure to pull the stamp further off the panel to avoid unwanted lines.

Card #4



- Brown Card with Robin's Egg Panel
 - Dark Celery CutApart: "Happy Anniversary"
 - Robin's Egg CutApart: "Happy Anniversary"
 - Round Sparkle Brad
 - Corner Rounder
1. Round the upper right and lower left corners of the Robin's Egg panel. Round the upper left and lower right corners of the CutAparts.



Card #5



- Brown Card with Robin's Egg Panel
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Stone Die Cut Tag: "U are the Reason..."
- Dark Celery CutApart: "Happy Birthday to You"
- Round Sparkle Brad
- CS® "Earth" Ink
- Scrap Paper for Masking

1. Tear a piece of paper and place onto the panel to use as a mask. Sponge Earth ink over the paper edge and stamp the area with the UM background image. Create as many masked areas as you like.

Set C: 5x7 Robin's Egg Cards with Brown and Stone Text Panels

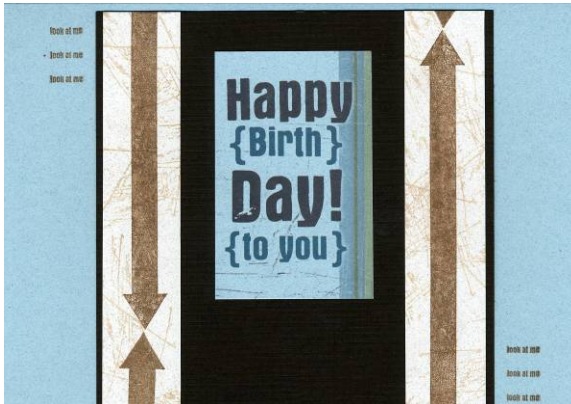
Card #1



- Robin's Egg Card with Brown and Stone Text Panels
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Stone Die Cut Tag: "Happy Anniversary"
- CS® "Earth" Ink

1. Stamp the UM narrow stripe image horizontally and vertically onto the Stone Text panel with Earth ink to create a plaid. Stamp without re-inking to vary the shade.

Card #2

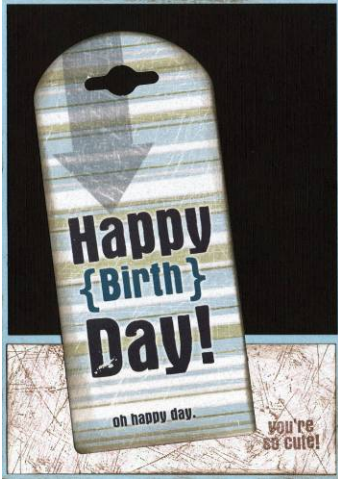


- Robin's Egg Card with Brown and Stone Text Panels
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Robin's Egg CutApart: "Happy Birthday to You!"
- CS® "Earth" Ink

1. Cut the Stone panel in half vertically, and stamp with the UM arrow images and Earth ink.

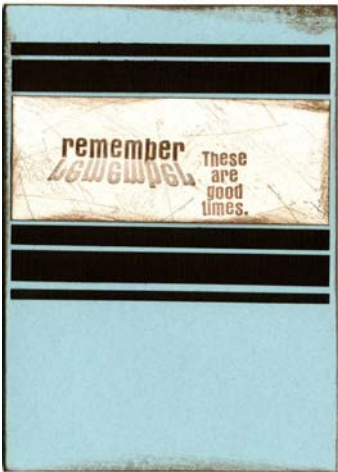


Card #3



- Robin's Egg Card with Brown and Stone Text Panels
 - Stone Die Cut Tag: "Happy Birthday!"
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - CS® "Earth" Ink
1. Stamp the UM background image onto the Stone Text panel with Earth ink. Try stamping twice without re-inking to create more depth to the background.

Card #4



- Robin's Egg Card with Brown and Stone Text Panels
 - Stamp Xtra: "Remember"
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - CS® "Earth" Ink
1. Stamp the UM background image onto the Stone Text panel with Earth ink. Stamp off some of the ink before stamping onto the panel to keep the background light.
 2. Trim the Brown panel into several narrow strips of varying widths to create a border above and below the Stone Text panel.

Card #5



- Robin's Egg Card with Brown Text Panel
 - Light Celery Panel (from Set A)
 - Robin's Egg CutApart: "Wishing You the Best"
 - Stone Die Cut Tag: "Love ya!"
 - Blue Organza Ribbon
 - Miniature Brad
1. Stretch a length of organza around the bottom of the Brown panel; tape ends at the back. Tie a short piece of organza onto the stretched ribbon length—easy!
