November 2009 Greetings to Go Solstice

Materials:

- Solstice Greetings to Go
- Solstice Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds and Font
- Solstice CS® Wood Mounted “Circular Solstice” Stamp
- Solstice Wood Mounted “You’re So Sweet” Greeting Stamp
- Solstice Art Nouveau “Light That Shines Within” Stamp

Tools:

- Bone Folder
- Paper Trimmer
- CS® Grid Ruler
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Foam Adhesive
- Black Photo Mounting Corners
- Piercing Tool and Cork Board
- CS® Palette Inks: Onyx, Topaz, Ruby and Sapphire
- Glitter Glue
- Colored Pencils
- Watercolor Pencils and Waterbrush
- Craft Knife and Cutting Mat

Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of many finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

Remove the die cuts from the 8.5x11 sheet. Trim the 12x12 Cutapart at 9, 6, and 3”. Cut the 3x12 strips at 9, 6, and 3”.

If you do not have an item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use items that you have in your stash.



Set A: 4-1/2 x 6-1/4" White Gloss Gate Fold Cards with (2) 2x6" Yellow Panels

Card #1



- White Gloss Card with Yellow Panel
 - White Cutaparts
 - Yellow Die Cut: "Thank You Very Much"
 - WM "Circular Solstice" Stamp
1. Stamp one Yellow panel with the WM image and Topaz ink.
 2. Attach the Yellow die cut to the lower right corner of the White cutapart. Sandwich the cutapart between the Yellow panel when attaching to the left gate fold of the card.

Card #2



- White Gloss Card with Yellow Panel
 - White Cutapart
 - Yellow Die Cut: "Feel Better Soon"
 - Yellow Ribbon
1. Apply adhesive to the left edge of one Yellow panel. Attach the panel to the inside of the left gate fold of the card.
 2. Tie a ribbon to the upper left and lower right corners of the punched holes in the Yellow die cut. Layer onto the White cutapart with foam adhesive and attach to the left gate fold.

Card #3



- White Gloss Card with Yellow Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Ink the UM image with Topaz; add more colors to portions of the image, and stamp onto the White Gloss card. Repeat.
 2. Using Sapphire ink, stamp the UM dotted half-circle image several times onto the card. Stamp the greeting into the upper left corner with Onyx.
 3. Attach one Yellow panel to the top of the front edge of the left gate fold. (Tuck the panel behind the right gate fold.) Hide a second stamped greeting on the lower right corner of the Yellow Panel.

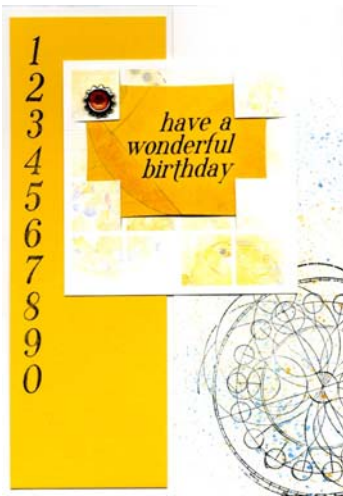


Card #4



- White Gloss Card with Yellow Panels
 - White Cutapart: "Happy Anniversary"
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM image onto each Yellow Panel as shown with Onyx ink. Color the individual circles of the stamped image with colored pencils.
 2. Using a craft knife, cut along the edges of the stamped circles to create slots for the White cutapart.
 3. Attach the Yellow panels onto the gate folds of the card. Avoid getting adhesive near the slits in the panel. Insert the corners of the cutapart into the slits. To open the card, remove the cutapart.

Card #5



- White Gloss Card with Yellow Panel
 - Yellow Die Cut: "Have a Wonderful Day"
 - White Cutapart
 - UM Font
 - WM "Circular Solstice" Stamp
 - Yellow Star Brad
1. Stamp the left corner of one Yellow panel with the number list from the UM Font sheet and Onyx ink. Attach the panel to the left gate fold of the card.
 2. Stamp the right gate fold of the White Gloss card with the WM image and Onyx ink. Splatter the fold with yellow and blue watercolors.
 3. Use a craft knife to cut corners from the pre-printed squares of the White cutapart, as shown. Slide the corners of the Yellow die cut into the slots. Add a brad to the upper left corner.

Set B: 3-1/4 x 6-1/4" Sky Cards with 3x6" White Gloss Panels

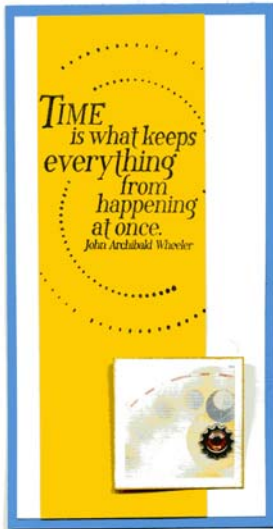
Card #1



- Sky Card with White Gloss Panel
 - 2x6 Yellow Panel (Set A)
 - (2) Blue Star Brads
 - Yellow Die Cut: "Happy Birthday!"
1. Trim the Yellow panel vertically at 1". Cut the White Glossy panel vertically at 1.75". Nest the two panels.
 2. Using a ruler and craft knife, cut slots in the Yellow die cut from the pre-punched holes in the top corners to the bottom corners.
 3. Insert the nested panels into the slots, attach a brad at each end, and mount onto the Sky card.

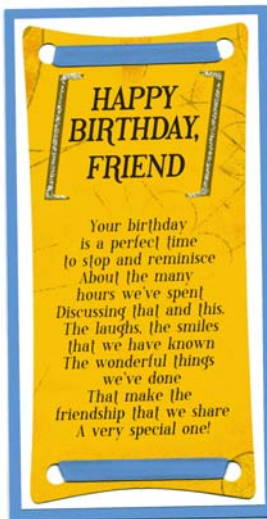


Card #2



- Sky Card with White Gloss Panel
 - Yellow Panel (Set A)
 - White Cutapart
 - Yellow Star Brad
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM greeting and background image onto the Yellow panel with Onyx ink. Nest onto the White Gloss panel and Sky card.
 2. Trim the White cutapart into four sections. Attach a brad to one trimmed cutapart, as shown, and mount onto the card with foam adhesive.

Card #3



- Sky Card with White Gloss Panel
 - Blue Satin Ribbon
 - Yellow Die Cut: "Happy Birthday, Friend"
1. Thread ribbon through the pre-punched holes of the Yellow die cut and attach at the back. Layer onto the White Gloss panel and the Sky card.
 2. Add glitter glue to the brackets on the Yellow die cut and set aside to dry.

Card #4



- Sky Card with White Gloss Panel
 - Yellow Die Cut: "You Are So Sweet"
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Yellow Ribbon
1. Stamp the UM image at an angle onto the upper left and lower right corners of the White Gloss panel. Color the smaller circles with colored pencils.
 2. Tie ribbon onto the lower left and upper right corners of the Yellow die cut.
 3. Cut slots along the inner edges of the stamp images on the White Gloss panel. Slide the Yellow die cut into the slots, and attach the panel to the card.



Card #5



- Sky Card with White Gloss Panel
- 1x6" Yellow Panel (Set B, Card #1)
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- WM "You're So Sweet" Stamp
- Blue Organza Ribbon

1. Stamp the entire White Gloss panel with the UM image and Topaz ink. Layer onto the Sky card.
2. Stamp the greeting onto the 1x6" Yellow panel and attach to the card. Finish with a bow.

Set C: 4-3/4 x 4-3/4" Blue Metallic Card with 4-1/2 x 4-1/2" White and 4x4" Sky Panels
Card #1



- Blue Metallic Card with White and Sky Panels
- Yellow Die Cut: "Get Well Soon"
- Blue Satin Ribbon

1. Tie a bow onto each corner of the Yellow die cut. Layer onto the Sky panel with foam adhesive.
2. Nest the Sky and White panels onto the Blue Metallic card.

Card #2



- Blue Metallic Card with White and Sky Panels
- Yellow Die Cut: "I Miss You!"
- White Cutapart
- Blue Organza Ribbon

1. Layer the White cutapart onto the upper left corner of the Sky panel.
2. Thread ribbon through the holes on the right side of the Yellow die cut. Attach the die cut to the Sky panel with foam tape. Layer the Sky panel onto the White panel and bring ribbon ends around to the back.
3. Attach the panels to the card.



Card #3



- Blue Metallic Card with White and Sky Panels
- White Cutapart
- Blue Star Brad

1. Trim the cutapart into four smaller squares, using the art as a guideline.
2. Secure a brad to one of the squares and attach to the Sky panel at a slight angle with foam adhesive. Layer the remaining squares directly onto the panel, and attach to the White panel and card.

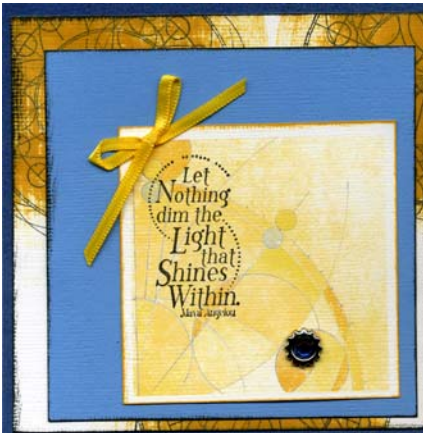
Card #4



- Blue Metallic Card with White and Sky Panels
- Yellow Die Cut: "Happy Anniversary"
- WM "Circular Solstice" Stamp
- Black Photo Mounting Corners

1. Stamp the Sky panel with the WM image and Sapphire ink. Nest the Sky and White panel onto the card.
2. Layer the Yellow die cut onto the card with black photo mounting corners.

Card #5



- Blue Metallic Card with White and Sky Panels
- White Cutapart
- WM "Circular Solstice" Stamp
- Art Nouveau Stamp
- Blue Star Brad
- Yellow Ribbon

1. Stamp the White panel with the WM image and Onyx ink. Allow the ink to dry, and apply Topaz ink directly to the stamped images to add color.
2. Attach a blue brad to the White cutapart. Stamp the quote into the upper left corner and attach to the lower right corner of the Sky panel.
3. Nest the Sky and White panels onto the card.
