November 2010 Greetings to Go All That Jazz

Materials:

- *All That Jazz* Greetings to Go
- *All That Jazz* Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds and FontArt
- *All That Jazz* Wood Mounted “Symphony” Stamp

Tools and Supplies:

- 12” Paper Trimmer
- Adhesive
- CS® Grid Ruler
- Paper Piercing Tool and Cork Board
- Foam Adhesive
- Tape
- CS® Onyx, Earth, Fuchsia, Topaz, Moss, India Ink Black, and White Pigment Ink
- Colored Pencils
- Watercolor Pencils
- Waterbrush
- Black Photo Mounting Corners
- CS® Bookbinding Glue or ATG Adhesive
- Crystal Facets (CS® Kit Goodie)
- Scrap Paper for Masking

Measurement Conversions:

.25 = 1/4”

.5 = 1/2”

.75 = 3/4”

Notes: Trim the 12x12 White Cutparts into sections as indicated by the cutting guidelines. Remove the Yellow die cuts from the parent sheet. Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned.

The edges of many finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

If you do not have an item required to complete a card, simply omit the step or substitute the item.



Set A: 5x7" Green Die Cut Shadowbox Cards with 4-3/4x6-3/4" White Panels

To create the Green shadowbox cards, remove the die cut oval, fold on all score lines. Glue the outermost scored tab area to the inside top flap of the card, directly adjacent to the scoreline. Visit the Cinema for an instructional video.

Card #1



- Green Card with White Panel
- Yellow Die Cut: "Just a Quick Note"
- White Cutapart: "Congratulations"
- Green Oval Die Cut
- Brown Ribbon
- (2) Gold Miniature Brads
- UM Borders & Backgrounds

1. Stamp the perimeter of the Green oval die cut with the UM leaf image and white pigment ink.
2. Thread the Yellow die cut with the brown ribbon and secure each end with a gold mini brad. Layer onto the Green die cut.

3. Attach the Green die cut to the White panel and secure ribbon ends at back. Nest the panel onto the card.
4. Attach the White cutapart to the inside of the card. Glue the scored end tab to the top inside card flap to create the shadowbox.

Card #2



- Green Card with White Panel
- White Cutapart: "Happy Birthday"
- UM Borders & Backgrounds

1. Stamp the UM circle image onto the White panel as shown with India Ink. Attach the White cutapart to the panel and layer the panel onto the card.
2. Prepare the inside of the die cut window as you wish and glue the scored end tab to create the shadowbox. (We stamped the WM "Symphony" image and a UM greeting with White Pigment Ink.)

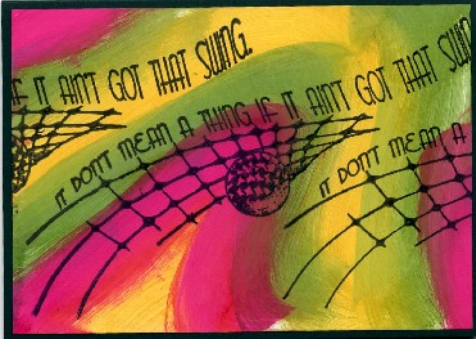
Card #3



- Green Card with White Panel
- White Cutapart: "With Deepest Sympathy" and "I'm So Sorry"

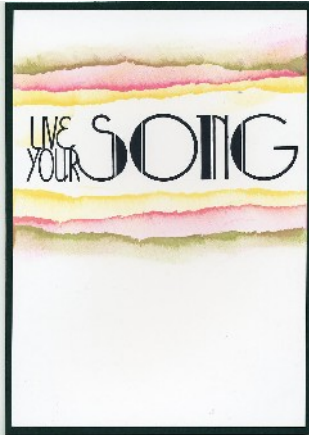
1. Using the Topaz, Moss and Fuchsia inks, slide the edge of the pad along the White panel in a wavy motion to create a background.
2. Attach the White cutapart to the panel and layer the panel onto the card.
3. Adhere the "I'm So Sorry" cutapart to the inside of the die cut window. Glue the scored tab to create the shadowbox.

Card #4



- Green Card with White Panel
 - UM FontArt
 - White Cutapart: "May Your Day Be a Joyful Song"
1. Apply Moss, Topaz and Fuchsia inks directly to the White panel and blend with a facial tissue or cloth.
 2. Stamp the UM image several times onto the panel and layer onto the card.
 3. Attach the White cutapart to the inside of the card and adhere the scored tab to create the shadowbox.

Card #5



- Green Card with White Panel
 - White Cutapart: "Happy Anniversary"
 - UM FontArt
1. Stamp the UM "Live Your Song" image onto the White panel with India Ink.
 2. Tear a piece of scrap paper and use as a mask above and below the stamped image. Sponge layers of Topaz, Moss and Fuchsia ink over the mask to create a colorful background.
 3. Attach the White cutapart to the inside of the card and glue the scored tab in place to create the shadowbox.

Set B: 4-1/2x6-1/4" Brown Cards with 4x5-3/4" Fuchsia and 3-3/4x5-1/2" White Panels

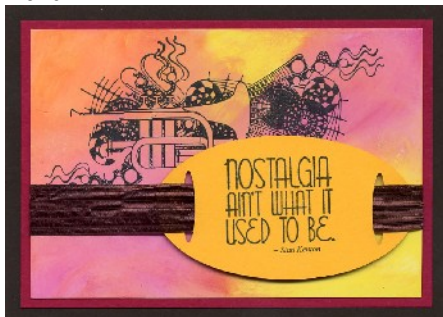
Card #1



- Brown Card with Fuchsia and White Panels
 - White Cutapart: Border Strip
 - Yellow Die Cut: "Congratulations"
 - (2) Gold Miniature Brads
 - Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds
1. Attach the Yellow die cut to the White cutapart with gold mini brads. Layer at an angle onto the Fuchsia panel, wrapping the ends around to the back.
 2. Stamp the UM image above and below the cutapart with Onyx ink. Nest the panel onto the card. Attach the White panel to the inside of the card.



Card #2



- Brown Card with Fuchsia and White Panels
- Yellow Die Cut: "Happy Birthday" (Plain Side)
- Brown fiber
- UM Borders & Backgrounds

1. Apply Topaz and Fuchsia ink to the White panel directly from the pad, blending with a facial tissue or cloth. Stamp the UM image onto the panel with Onyx ink.
2. Stamp the UM greeting onto the plain side of the Yellow die cut and thread with ribbon. Attach to the White panel with foam adhesive and wrap ends around to the back.
3. Nest onto the Fuchsia panel and Brown card.

Card #3



- Brown Card with Fuchsia and White Panels
- UM FontArt
- WM "Symphony" Stamp
- Crystal Facets

1. Stamp the UM "All That Jazz" image onto the White panel with Onyx ink. Attach a crystal to the first letter of each word with CS® Bookbinding Glue.
2. Stamp the WM image above and below the stamped greeting with Moss, Topaz and Fuchsia inks.
3. Nest the White panel onto the Fuchsia panel and card.

Card #4



- Brown Card with Fuchsia and White Panels
- UM FontArt

1. Stamp the UM "Live Your Song" quote at an angle onto the White panel with Onyx ink.
2. Stamp repeatedly around the image at the same angle with Fuchsia, Earth and Topaz inks to create a brick-like pattern.
3. Nest the White and Fuchsia panels onto the card.

Card #5



- Brown Card with Fuchsia and White Panels
- White Cutapart: "Thanx!"
- Fuchsia Velvet Ribbon
- WM "Symphony" Stamp

1. Stamp the WM image onto the Brown card with CS® White Pigment ink. Heat set to dry.
2. Trim the Fuchsia panel vertically at 2.25". Nest the cutapart onto the trimmed panel and attach to the Brown card.
3. Tie a bow with the velvet ribbon and attach.



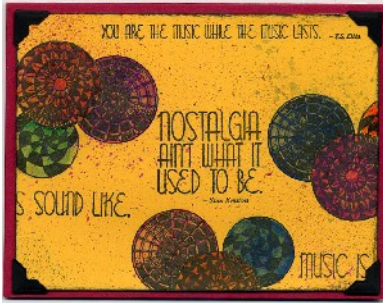
Set C: 4-1/4x5-1/2" Fuchsia Cards with 4x5-1/4" Yellow Panels

Card #1



- Fuchsia Card with Yellow Panel
 - WM "Symphony" Stamp
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Black Photo Mounting Corners
1. Stamp the WM image onto the Yellow panel with Fuchsia ink. Stamp the UM quote onto the bottom of the panel with Onyx ink.
 2. Attach the Yellow panel to the Fuchsia card with black photo mounting corners.

Card #2



- Fuchsia Card with Yellow Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Black Photo Mounting Corners
1. Stamp the UM circle image three times onto the Yellow panel with Onyx ink. Color the stamped images with watercolor pencils and blend with a waterbrush. Splatter the entire panel with assorted watercolors.
 2. Stamp additional UM quotes onto the panel with Onyx ink.
 3. Attach the Yellow panel to the Fuchsia card with black photo mounting corners.

Card #3



- Fuchsia Card with Yellow Panel
 - Green Oval Die Cut (From Set A)
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Crystal Facets
1. Stamp the UM images onto the Green die cut with White Pigment Ink. Attach the crystal facets to the stamped images with bookbinding glue.
 2. Layer the die cut onto the Yellow panel and trim the overlapping edges to fit. Attach the panel to the card.

Card #4



- Fuchsia Card with Yellow Panel
 - Yellow Die Cut: "Thank You"
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Fuchsia Velvet Ribbon
1. Stamp the UM circle image onto the Yellow panel with Topaz ink until the entire panel is covered with several layers of the image.
 2. Thread the Yellow die cut with ribbon and attach to the panel with foam adhesive. Wrap ribbon ends around to the back of the panel and layer the panel onto the card.

Card #5



- Fuchsia Card with Yellow Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM guitar image onto the Yellow panel with India Ink Black. Color the image with watercolor pencils or colored pencils.
 2. Stamp the UM quotes onto the panel, as shown. Nest the panel onto the card.
