Materials:

- Give Thanks Special Edition Collection
- Give Thanks Unmounted Stamps

Tools and Supplies:

- 12" Paper Trimmer
- Adhesive
- Scor-it Board (Optional)
- Bone Folder
- CS® India Ink Black
- Watercolor Pencils
- Corner Rounder
- Foam Adhesive
- Craft Knife and Cutting Mat
- Rotary Blade (Optional)

Measurement Conversions:

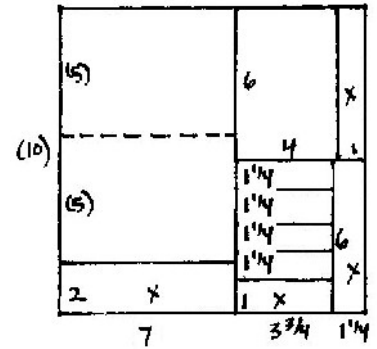
.25 = $\frac{1}{4}$ "
.5 = $\frac{1}{2}$ "
.75 = $\frac{3}{4}$ "

Note: The instructions do not utilize the entire paper collection. Five 12x12 papers, six 8.5x11 papers, three 4.25x6.25 photo mattes and several cutaparts are used. The remaining papers, mattes and cutaparts can be used for scrapbooking and additional card making or paper crafting projects.



Cutting Instructions

1. Cut one 12x12 Blue Plain at 7". Trim the 5x12 horizontally at 10". Cut the 5x12 horizontally at 6". Trim one 5x6 vertically at 4". Cut the other 5x6 vertically at 3.75". Trim the 3.75x6 horizontally at 5, 3.75, 2.5 and 1.25". Repeat cutting instructions for one 12x12 Tan Plain and one 12x12 Clay Plain. Score each 7x10 horizontally at 5" and fold into 5x7 cards.

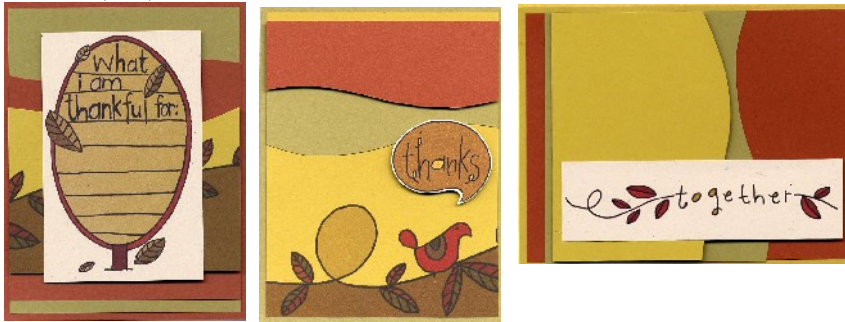


Card #1, #2 and #3



- 5x10 Blue, Sand and Clay Folded Cards
- 4.25x6.25 Blue, Clay and Yellow Photo Mattes
- (4) 1.25x3.75 Blue, Clay and Sand Panels
- 4x6 Blue, Clay and Sand Panels
- Sand Cutaparts

Card #4, #5, and #6



- 5.5x8.5 Clay, Leaf and Sunflower Print Folded Cards
- 4x5.25 Clay, Leaf and Sunflower Panels
- Assorted Free-Cut Clay, Leaf and Sunflower Panels
- Sand Cutaparts

Card #7, #8, #9, #10, #11 and #12



- 5x10 Sand Print, Leaf and Clay Folded Cards
- 3.5x7 Sand Print, Leaf and Clay Folded Cards
- (2) each 1x2, 1x1 and 2x3.5 Sand Print, Leaf and Clay Panels
- Unmounted Stamps

Card #13, #14, #15, and #16



- (2) each 4x12 Clay and Blue Folded Cards
 - (2) each 5.75x3.75 Clay and Blue Panels
 - Unmounted Stamps
1. Stamp the UM image onto each panel with India Ink. Cut around the stamped rectangle and tree with a ruler and craft knife. Stamp a UM greeting above each tree image.
 2. Layer the cut panel onto the card with foam adhesive.
