

Assembly Line Scrapbooking

December 2008 *Greetings to Go* Milestones

Materials:

- € Milestones Greetings to Go
- € Milestones WM Stamp
- € Milestones WM "Thank You" Stamp
- € Milestones Unmounted Font and Borders & Backgrounds

Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making crease, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of most finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with black or blackberry ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

If you do not have the item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use the items that you have in your stash.



Set A: 5-1/4x8 Boysenberry Cards with Green Tea Panels

Card #1



- € Boysenberry Card with Green Tea Panel
- € Paper Distressing Tool
- € Green Die Cut: "Thanks a Lot!"
- € Blackberry Ink
- € Unmounted Font

1. Distress the perimeter of the card with the tool.
2. Stamp asterisk and lettering onto the Green Tea panel and crinkle to distress.

Card #2



- € Boysenberry Card with Green Tea Panel
- € Earl Grey Die Cut: "Happy Birthday!"
- € UM Borders & Backgrounds
- € Black Ink

1. Trim die cut to fit.
2. Stamp UM image off of the left and right edges of the panel with black ink.



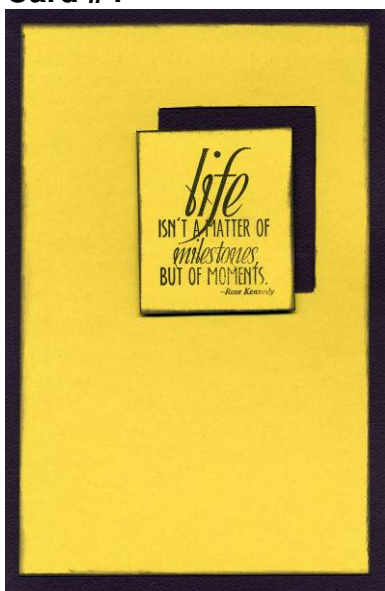
Card #3



- € Boysenberry Card with Green Tea Panel
- € Earl Grey Die Cuts: (2) Hinges
- € Soft White Die Cut: "Happy Birthday to You!"

1. Trim the die cut to fit the card panel.
2. Fold the Earl Grey hinges over the left and right edges of the panel, centering onto the die cut.

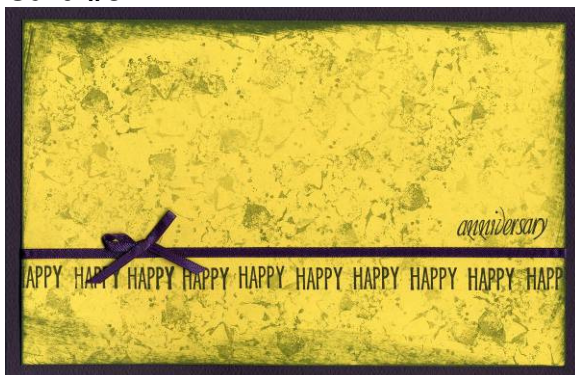
Card #4



- € Boysenberry Card with Green Tea Panel
- € UM Borders & Backgrounds
- € Blackberry Ink

1. Stamp the UM image onto the card with Blackberry ink.
2. Carefully trim the image from the panel with a ruler and craft knife.
3. Ink the edges of the stamped quote and layer onto the panel with foam tape, slightly offset from the window in the panel.

Card #5



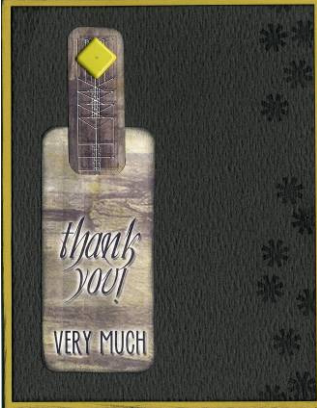
- € Boysenberry Card with Green Tea Panel
- € Blackberry and Black Ink
- € Purple Satin Ribbon
- € UM Borders & Backgrounds

1. Stamp the UM background image onto the Green Tea panel with Blackberry ink. (Stamp off ink before stamping onto panel for a softer image.)
2. Stamp a straight row of "happy" onto the lower edge of the panel.
3. Place the ribbon onto the card, tie a bow, and attach to the ribbon.
4. Stamp the word "Anniversary" just above the ribbon.



Set B: 4-1/4x5-1/2 Green Tea Cards with Earl Grey Panels

Card #1



- € Green Tea Card with Earl Grey Panel
- € Soft White Die Cuts: “Thank You Very Much” and Panel
- € Green Tea Square Brad
- € UM Font
- € Black Ink

1. Thread the narrow die cut into the opening of the “Thank You” die cut. Attach with a brad.
2. Stamp the UM asterisk image onto the right edge of the card with black ink.

Card #2



- € Green Tea Card with Earl Grey Panel
- € UM Borders & Backgrounds
- € WM “Thank You” Image
- € Black Ink

1. Stamp the “Thank You” image onto the right edge of the Green Tea card with black ink. Stamp into the center first, and then above and below.
2. Stamp a pattern with the UM triple panel image and black ink onto the Earl Grey panel. Trim 1” from the panel and attach to the card.

Card #3



- € Green Tea Card with Earl Grey Panel
- € Cream Satin Ribbon
- € Green Tea Die Cuts: “I Miss You” and “Get Well Soon”
- € UM Borders & Backgrounds
- € Black Ink

1. Stamp the UM background image into each corner of the Earl Grey panel with black ink.
2. Thread the ribbon through the Green Tea die cut and wrap ends around to the back of the panel. Tie a bow and attach to the ribbon.
3. Attach the “I Miss You” die cut with foam adhesive to add dimension.



Card #4



- € Green Tea Card with Earl Grey Panel
- € Purple Satin Ribbon
- € Earl Grey Die Cut: "Thank you!"

1. Trim Earl Grey die cut to the fit the panel; attach.
2. Stretch purple ribbon above and below the die cut; tape the ribbon ends around to the back of the panel.
3. Enjoy the simplicity!

Card #5



- € Green Tea Card with Earl Grey Panel
- € Green Tea Die Cut: "Hello"
- € UM Borders & Backgrounds
- € Black ink
- € Green Tea Square Brad

1. Stamp the UM image onto the Earl Grey panel with black ink, creating a diagonal pattern.
2. Trim the die cut to fit the panel and accent with a brad.

Set C: 4x9-1/4 Earl Grey Cards with Boysenberry and Soft White Panels

Card #1



- € Earl Grey Card with Boysenberry and Soft White Panels
- € Green Tea Die Cut: "Happy Birthday"
- € WM Panel Stamp
- € Purple Satin Ribbon

1. Stamp WM image onto the Soft White panel with Blackberry ink. Mask the image and sponge with additional Blackberry ink.
2. Tie ribbon onto the die cut and attach to the panels.



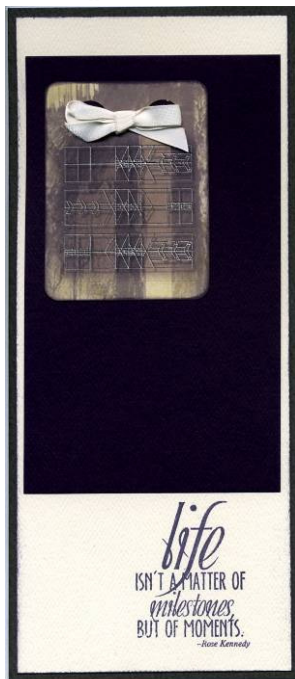
Card #2



- € Earl Grey Card with Boysenberry and Soft White Panels
- € Soft White Die Cut: "Thank You, Thank You, Thank You"
- € (2) Boysenberry Square Brads

1. Attach the Soft White die cut with adhesive. Pierce through the panel to attach the brads.

Card #3



- € Earl Grey Card with Boysenberry and Soft White Panels
- € Soft White Die Cut: "Triple Panel"
- € Cream Satin Ribbon
- € UM Borders & Backgrounds
- € Blackberry Ink

1. Thread the ribbon through the large holes of the die cut and attach to the Boysenberry panel.
2. Stamp the UM image onto the lower right corner of the Soft White panel with Blackberry ink.



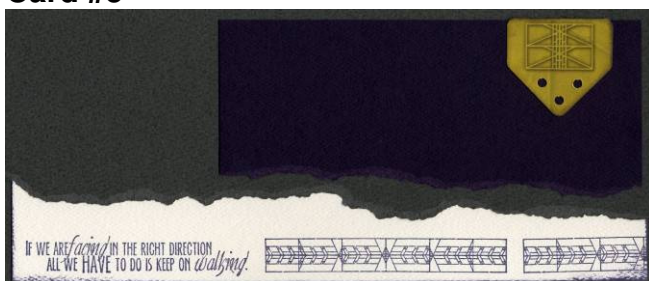
Card #4



- € Earl Grey Card with Boysenberry and Soft White Panels
- € Earl Grey Die Cut: "Get Well Soon!"
- € (2) Gold Square Brads
- € UM Borders & Backgrounds
- € Blackberry Ink

1. Stamp the Soft White panel with the UM background image and Blackberry ink. (Stamp off ink before stamping onto panel for softer look.)
2. Attach the Earl Grey die cut and secure gold brads into die cut openings.

Card #5



- € Earl Grey Card with Boysenberry and Soft White Panels
- € Green Tea Die Cut: Hinge
- € UM Borders & Backgrounds
- € Blackberry Ink

1. Stamp the UM image and quote onto the lower portion of the Soft White panel with Blackberry ink. Attach to the inside of the card.
2. Tear away the lower front flap of the Earl Grey card and the lower portion of the Boysenberry panel.
3. Attach the Green Tea hinge to the upper right corner of the Boysenberry panel.
